## Methods and tools for bibliographic research and scientific text elaboration

The holder of this badge has attended the course "Methods and tools for bibliographic research and scientific text elaboration" organized by the University Basilicata as part of the "Competenze trasversali in Unibas" Project.

The course aims at providing students with theoretical and methodological principles of bibliographic research, offering the essential coordinates of the discipline with particular attention to the international context and its most recent variations. Bibliography will serve as a stimulus to deepen the knowledge of catalogues, contemporary bibliographic repertoires and digitally specialized databases. Books and documents will be identified in bibliographical terms in both paper and digital formats. During class time, students will have the opportunities to have practical exercises that will allow them to practice the theoretical tools necessary to develop the bibliographic research mostly relevant to their field of interest; they will also acquire the ability to become familiar with different categories of documents and with their bibliographic and cataloguing representations. The aspects related to the recent types of libraries and services for users will also be in depth studied, also in light of the regulations on copyright and the digital administration code.



### Skills

The owner of this Badge has displayed the following soft skills:

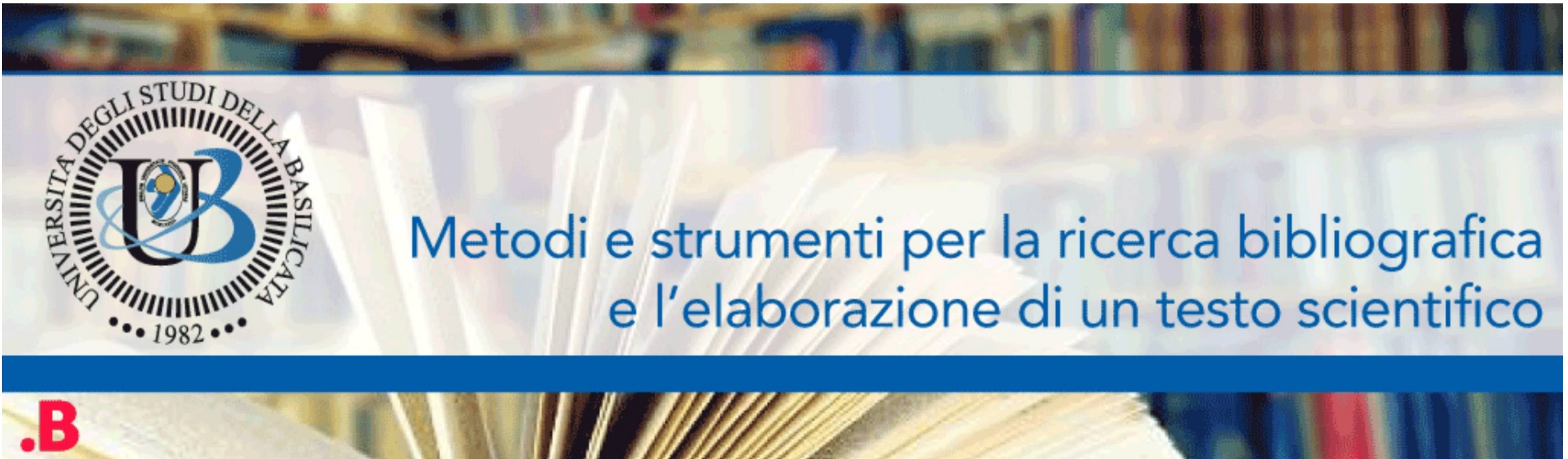
- Ability to exercise a critical spirit in evaluating sources.

- Ability to communicate effectively and pertinently the results of their didactic and scientific papers.
- Ability to evaluate and adopt the principles of open access to scientific knowledge.

The owner of this Badge has displayed an overall knowledge in:

- Bibliographic research and elaboration of a scientific text.
- Critical use and evaluation of sources contained in catalogues, databases, open archives, digital libraries, search engines.

### Criteria

The Badge is awarded following the attendance of at least 70% of the hours of the course "Methods and tools for bibliographic research and scientific text elaboration" and provides for the elaboration of a bibliographic search relevant to one's own course of study / field of disciplinary interest that demonstrates the ability to orient oneself among the tools presented during the lessons as well as bibliographic citation methods analyzed.



### Issued by University of Basilicata

The University of Basilicata is the leading University of the Basilicata region, in the Southern part of Italy. Since 2012, according to the new University statute and rules of procedure, ex D.R. n. 88/2012, the University of Basilicata is organized through six primary structures (precisely four departments and two schools) in which the functions and the personnel of the pre-existing twelve departments and eight faculties have been re-addressed. Degree programs range from the Humanities, to architecture, archeology, education, economics and management, as well as to the STEM disciplines (hard sciences, agriculture, engineering, computer sciences). Such degree programs are effectively connected to the research, training and third mission activities developed by the primary structures. University of Basilicata counts about 7000 students, and is based in the cities of Potenza and Matera.
