## Epic Finance! Cooperative and mutual financial education

The holder of this badge has attended the course "Epic Finance! Cooperative and mutual financial education" organized by the University Basilicata as part of the "Competenze trasversali in Unibas" Project.

The course aims to develop financial knowledge and skills for better management of one's money in order to make more informed financial choices.

The objective is to share awareness and knowledge with young people on the basics of financial education, civil economy and, not least, to develop the issues and characteristics of credit cooperation, starting from the value references of Cooperative Credit to deepen the meaning and action of community banks.

The teaching modules will be as follows:

- Financial Education - The Italian legislative framework, best practices and savings
- Civil Economy
- Cooperative credit banks, a different system
- Digital payments



## Skills

The owner of this badge has proved to have the following skills:

In accordance with the guidelines of the Ministry of Economy and Finance, and the Committee for the Planning and Coordination of Financial Education Activities, the basic skills included in the pathway are:

- Money and prices area: having awareness of the different forms and functions of money; understanding the value of goods and money; understanding the variability of value
- Payments and purchasing area: manage and control financial and economic transactions
- Income and planning area: understand the concept of income and the factors that determine it; be able to manage one's resources appropriately; be able to plan, manage and monitor income and expenses
- Savings and investment area: manage savings and investments
- Credit area: be able to use credit appropriately
- Risk awareness and management area: be aware of major risks with negative financial consequences; understand and manage financial risks
- Protection and self-protection tools area: to safeguard one's rights and fulfill one's duties in financial and economic matters
- Financial intermediaries and regulation area: having cognizance of the economic-financial environment

## Issued by University of Basilicata

The University of Basilicata is the leading University of the Basilicata region, in the Southern part of Italy. Since 2012, according to the new University statute and rules of procedure, ex D.R. n. 88/2012, the University of Basilicata is organized through six primary structures (precisely four departments and two schools) in which the functions and the personnel of the pre-existing twelve departments and eight faculties have been re-addressed. Degree programs range from the Humanities, to architecture, archeology, education, economic and management, as well as to the STEM disciplines (hard sciences, agriculture, engineering, computer sciences). Such degree programs are effectively connected to the research, training and third mission activities developed by the primary structures. University of Basilicata counts about 7.000 students, and is based in the cities of Potenza and Matera.
