

Theatrical writing and performances workshop

The holder of this badge has attended the course "Theatrical writing and performances workshop" organized by the University Basilicata as part of the "Competenze trasversali in Unibas" Project.

The Writing and Theatrical Performances Workshop is a path of creative writing and acting that comes in a broader program, MOEBIUS, for the students well-being. The workshop is held in the Laboratory of theatrical experiments and border writings. Yard of the contemporary imagination of the Department for Scientific and Social Humanistic Innovation. The project aims to provide an opportunity to carry out a practical activity staging texts of literature classics, reworked in writing according to the method of the Perfect circle SDP81, designed by Maria Teresa Imbriani.

The work to be carried out will include:

- the staging of a text that derives from the collective reading (in "circle" precisely) of the Gabriele d'Annunzio's Torch under the bushel tragedy and its rewriting by the students group in a contemporary key. This rewriting involves reflection on the family dynamics and gender roles on the one hand and on the other on the Artificial intelligence and digital media alienation;
- the public reading of selected steps from the Rocco Scotellaro's L'Uva puttarella, the autobiographical novel set in Basilicata, to be carried out in the places told.

The course includes a series of meetings aimed at the production of the work to be rewritten (under the tutor coordination), the show rehearsals and its staging on September 26, 2025. The aloud reading from the Rocco Scotellaro's novel will culminate in the public reading to be held in the Provincial Museum of Potenza on September 9, 2025 in memory of the city bombing in 1943. The course is divided into two-hour interactive lessons and involves external experts.

Skills

The recipient of this Badge proves to have the following competences:

- Ability to read and interpret a complex literary text
- Ability to produce dramatic texts through the Perfect circle SDP81 method
- Performative skills: public readings and acting of a dramatic text
- Capacity for collective and equal work
- Ability to follow an ethical and philanthropic code of conduct
- Active citizenship skills

The recipient of this Badge displays the following soft skills:

- Ability to demonstrate empathy through the emotion of reading
- Ability to interpret a text both in a theatrical performance and through reading aloud
- Ability to pay attention to details
- Ability to adopt a moral values code and respect for each other
- Ability to adapt to difficult conditions
- Ability to exercise critical sensibility in evaluating sources

The recipient of this Badge displays an overall knowledge in:

- Knowledge of dialogue writing and aloud reading techniques
- Knowledge of the tragedy of D'Annunzio's Torch under the bushel and its references, author, sources and context
- Knowledge of the Scotellaro's Uva puttarella, autobiographical novel, the author and its context
- Knowledge of the main techniques of dramatic writing
- Knowledge of the main techniques of theatrical and performative activity

Criteria

The Badge is awarded following the frequency of meetings, participation in the rewriting work and staging of the scheduled plaies.

The Badge is also awarded for partial attendance at the various activities (listeners/spectators and/or text writing and/or acting).

Attendance is compulsory (at least 50 percent).

The overall duration of the course is 60 hours.
